Help vulnerable neighbors prepare

Offer to pick up supplies that a vulnerable neighbor might need to remain comfortable during an extended power outage but cannot obtain themselves, or share yours.


You may want to ask a vulnerable neighbor questions, such as: Do you have enough medicine to last a week? Do you have enough water, bread and other non-perishable food items to last a week?



Help vulnerable neighbors evacuate

If an evacuation is ordered, make sure your vulnerable neighbors are able to drive on their own and have a safe place to go. If they don't:

Help them get to a county evacuation pick-up site or a shelter before the storm arrives.



Check in with vulnerable neighbors once the storm is over

Exchange contact information with a vulnerable neighbor so you can reach them and they can reach you. Keep in touch before, during and after the storm.
